Diagrams can be included in nonfiction texts to help readers to understand the information. Read the sentences below about 'What a Hoot!' and create a simple diagram for each one.

Nestled near the banks of the Garonne River in southwest France is a grouping of three conjoined owl-shaped cabins.

I saw migratory birds circling in the sky, looking for their former wetlands.

Inside, the owls are comprised of two levels, which are accessible by ladders.

Round nest-like beds are located in each of the owl's heads where campers can observe the Moon and the stars from owl eye windows.
